**CLASS B ASBESTOS REMOVAL LICENCE WITH CONDITIONS
NUMBER (509611)**

SafeWork SA has considered your application for a Class B Asbestos Removal Licence. We advise your application has been successful and that Licence Number (509611) has been granted for a period of five (5) years from (13/12/2013). This approval enables you to remove non-friable asbestos as per regulation 487, subject to conditions imposed by the regulator under regulation 502 of the *Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012 (SA)* (WHS Regulations).

All asbestos removal licence holders in South Australia are subject to conditions (refer to licence). Your licence is subject to the following additional condition:

The licence is only applicable to the removal of non-friable asbestos containing material located within infrastructure associated with pit, pipe and telecommunication networks.

The reason for this condition is the documentation supplied to the regulator only contains sufficient information to ensure compliance with this particular condition.

502—Conditions of licence

- (1) The regulator may impose any conditions it considers appropriate on an asbestos removal licence or asbestos assessor licence.
- (2) Without limiting sub regulation (1), the regulator may impose conditions in relation to 1 or more of the following:
 - a) control measures which must be implemented in relation to the carrying out of work or activities under the licence;
 - b) the recording or keeping of information;
 - c) requiring the licence holder or a nominated supervisor of the licence holder, to undergo retraining or reassessment during the term of the licence;
 - d) the provision of information to the regulator;
 - e) the nature of work or activities authorised by the licence;
 - f) the circumstances in which work or activities authorised by the licence may be carried out.

This additional condition does not prevent you from applying for a full class B asbestos removal licence in the future, subject to the provision of evidence to support a full class B asbestos removal licence.

A decision to impose a condition on a licence is a reviewable decision (see Regulation 676).

Regulation 466(1) of the WHS Regulations 2012 states: A licensed asbestos removalist must give written notice to the regulator at least five (5) days before the removalist commences licensed asbestos removal work. Notification is not required if you are removing less than 10m².

Please provide your notification to SafeWork SA via the SafeWork SA Notification Portal. To use the SafeWork SA Notification Portal, you need to be registered with SafeWork SA. If you do not have user login details, please contact the SafeWork SA Licensing Unit on telephone 8303 0400.

After the completion of each notified removal, a clearance certificate (provided by a party independent of the removal) and prescribed waste transfer certificate, must be provided by uploading the document/s via the SafeWork SA Notification Portal.

If you conduct licensed asbestos removal work at any workplace of the Commonwealth, a commonwealth public authority or a non-Commonwealth licensee (i.e. Telstra, NBN Co.) notification must be provided to Comcare at:

The *Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012 (SA)* are the principal regulations applicable to asbestos removal work.

In South Australia all applicants for asbestos removal licences are subject to the asbestos project audit. Please contact Principal Inspector, Brett Pfeffer on 8303 0417 or email to brett.pfeffer@sa.gov.au for further information.

I take this opportunity to remind you that as the licence holder it is your responsibility to ensure this Licence is renewed prior to its expiry date of (12/12/2018). It is recommended that you submit your renewal application at least six (6) weeks prior to this date to allow for processing.
